Announcement

Parsippany OEM/RACES will be hosting a one day Amateur Radio Technician Class licensing course on January 23rd, 2010 at the Parsippany Police Athletic League building located on Baldwin Rd. in Parsippany (near the Rt 46 intersection). The course will run approximately 7 hours, and the FCC Technician Class license test will be administered the same day at the conclusion of the course.

What you need to know

This one day course is a **review** of the study guide for students who have been studying at home towards obtaining the Technician Class License. We discourage students from waiting until the day of course to begin their studies, as this will likely result in a test failure. Studying for the test prior to this course, then actively participating in the all day review of the test Question Pool is our recommended approach to successfully acquiring this entry level license to the Amateur Radio Service. The course is free, however, there is an FCC required administrative fee of \$15 for taking license test.

Pre-registration is strongly recommended so that we may contact you if the class is postponed

Seating is **limited**, and we discourage walk-ins. There are **NO** residency requirements to participate. Once registered, you will receive an acknowledgement email with a reminder of what materials to bring with you to the class.

What To Bring to class

Bring at least one pencil/eraser, and a black ink pen. A **PHOTO ID**, or any two forms of positive identification as follows: Non-photo driver's license or other ID card (school or employer), Birth certificate (must have seal), Passport or Minor's work permit. Electronic calculators are permitted, though you may be asked to demonstrate your calculator is cleared of any programmable memory
